The Magnificent Seven Early 1900's The classic defense by seven motivated cowboys against the Bandittos.
Salamis 480 BC (15mm Naval) Athenians battle Persia's massive Phoenician, Egyptian, and Satellite Navy.
Napoleonic French and Russians 1812 (15mm scale) The Grande Armee with Poles, Bavarians, Saxons...
Napoleonic French and British 1815 (15mm scale) includes Prussians, Brunswick and others.

All castings required for these subjects are available. Many are already converted and painted. Many scenics are also built! French Napoleonics are the same figurines in each of these three periods. Other nationalities are additional figurines. As is obvious, many different scenarios may be offered by utilizing alternative scenic setups and alternative orders of battle for: Medieval Knights, French and Indian War, Northwest Frontier INDIA, Egyptians and Hittites (Kadesh), American Revolution (Cowpens, Guilford Courthouse, Eutaw Springs, Monmouth, Saratoga, Ticonderoga, etc. – I have all the types necessary for ANY battle), The Sudan has many scenarios not just the Arabi Revolt alternative, Pontiac's War can be replayed as Blue Jacket with much the same figures, The First Boer War is easily played using the Boers of the 2nd Boer War and the British of the Zulu War, and it is obvious you may use Napoleonics of all these nationalities for many scenarios...I have only delineated the states by name. Darkest Africa offers so many varying scenarios it is unbelievable because Tarzan and fantasy impinge heavily into this framework which can include "Lost Worlds". El Cid presents many scenarios utilizing varying alignments of Almoravid Berbers against Spanish Christians against Andalusian Moors. Saxons, Vikings and Normans are rather intertwined so Viking Raid! & Hastings both utilize the Saxons; and are termed The DARK AGES.

The scenic catalog of ScenoSquares offers impressive terrains from volcanoes and mountains to waterfalls and woodlands, from massive sculptures to intricate rock outcroppings, from bleak deserts to verdant grasslands. There are structures and buildings from every period of history and even the fantasy of Tolkien artfully conceived and crafted. These scenics are coupled with their appropriate figurines in packages although some miniature subjects may be acquired without scenics.
